FSCM MEDIATION TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP

Family Services of Central Massachusetts Mediation Program believes we should be a reflection of our whole community. In that spirit, we offer a Scholarship enabling us to assist individuals who may not otherwise have the opportunity to train as a mediator. In exchange for the scholarship, we require a mandatory one-year commitment to volunteer with our program volunteering 1x a month.

Scholarship Commitment

- ✓ Fulfill Practicum requirement after training which include observing 3 mediations and mediating 3 times with FSCM mediation staff before being added to our volunteer roster.
- ✓ Co-mediate with the FSCM Mediation Program thereafter for 1 year, once per month until completing a minimum of 12 mediation sessions as a volunteer mediator on our roster.
- ✓ Scholarship grantees unable to fulfill their commitment will be required to pay back 45% of the original cost of training.
- ✓ Scholarship grantees agree to be promoted via their name and/or photo on website and social media.
- ✓ Signing the application, accepting the Scholarship, and completing the mediation training in full is binding.
