Growing up, Xandra was close to a cousin of the same age who has Hydrocephalus, a neurological disorder that affects brain tissue. Xandra witnessed firsthand the struggles that accompany a disability and chose to help others with those struggles as her life's work. She pursued a degree in psychology and a career in health and human services. Gaining experience in residential treatment and working with individuals on the autism spectrum, Xandra may have found the perfect fit at Seven Hills. "In recreation, where there is energy and creativity, there is boundless opportunity," she said, adding, "taking smaller steps, realistically!"
