A Season of Perseverance, Pride—and Fun!—on the Court

The Special Olympics Massachusetts Basketball season wrapped up at the State Games on April 7, with three Seven Hills teams represented and finishing with style and pride.



The Seven Hills Panthers Unified team played a tough first game against the Shrewsbury Pioneers at St. Mark's School in Southborough, losing by just one point. The Panthers took command with a win in the second game against the north central Mass Marauders, ending their season with a silver medal. Volunteer coaches Steve Janulewicz and Dale Ellis led the team with an emphasis on developing skills while having fun and building friendships. In their seventh year with the program, the coaches exemplify remarkable dedication and spread their infectious positivity up and down the court.



At Babson College, the Seven Hills Coyotes Unified team brought home the gold medal for the second consecutive year! Defeating teams from Belmont and Hockomock, the Coyotes dominated the court with confidence while demonstrating exemplary sportsmanship. This team fueled their perseverance to the top with camaraderie and commitment. For over 10 years, Coach Kevin Heman has dedicated his time, expertise, and enthusiasm—even recruiting daughter, Coach Kelcy—to the Seven Hills Community Connections sports program.

New to the roster this year, the Seven Hills Scorpions competed as a traditional team with all athletes from our Fitchburg Family Resource Center on the floor at Weston High School. David Burke and Kevin Libby coached the team through a win and a loss and took home the silver medal.



The 14 athletes and their coaches marked an incredible first year together and ended the tournament with pride in their accomplishments. The season was such a positive experience, that all players reported they will return to the sport in 2025!

The Skills and Drills group gained experience each Sunday at Worcester State University. This well-attended activity was possible due to the volunteer coaching of Kevin Donovan, and Maura and Chris Eldridge. The athletes improved their basketball and team-building skills while making new friends and scoring heaps—and boundless leaps—of fun.
