JUST US GIRLS Fosters Fun, Friendship, and Self-Determination

Sheila Judkins understands when someone feels shy and hesitant. She also understands what it takes for someone to step outside their comfort zone and try something new.

Sheila is the director of Just Us Girls (JUG), a unique social growth and development program for girls, aged 10-19, with special needs. For the past 21 years, Sheila has been nurturing the senses of "self" in adolescent girls of varying abilities to gain self-awareness, self-determination, and self-advocacy. Using evidence-based curricula, JUG teaches social development skills such as building healthy relationships, bullying prevention, money management, health and wellness, personal safety, community engagement, and more.

"Our girls come to us to find friendships, learn to navigate social pressures, and find their own confidence and voice," Sheila said. It's not always easy, but it is rewarding...

Cora's "Just Us Girls" Journey



Cora joined Just Us Girls when she was 11 years old. Her mother hoped that JUG would provide Cora, who has Asperger

Syndrome, with the social skill-building she needed to make meaningful friendships. Early on, Cora was timid, shy, and reluctant to engage in the group's social conversations and activities. Significant anxiety required Cora to attend JUG sessions with support staff.

Perseverance was a team effort, and over the past 9 years, Cora has blossomed into a confident, self-determined young woman. She easily initiates conversations and speaks openly about her disability and the challenges she has overcome. She is more self-aware, better understands social cues, and recognizes her anxiety triggers.



Now 18 years old, Cora is attending the University of Rhode Island, pursuing a degree in Animal Sciences. She plans to return to Just Us Girls as a guest speaker to share her personal experience and the program's impact on her life. Of the only self-development program she has ever enjoyed, Cora said, "There's no passing judgment here. It's a safe spot.
